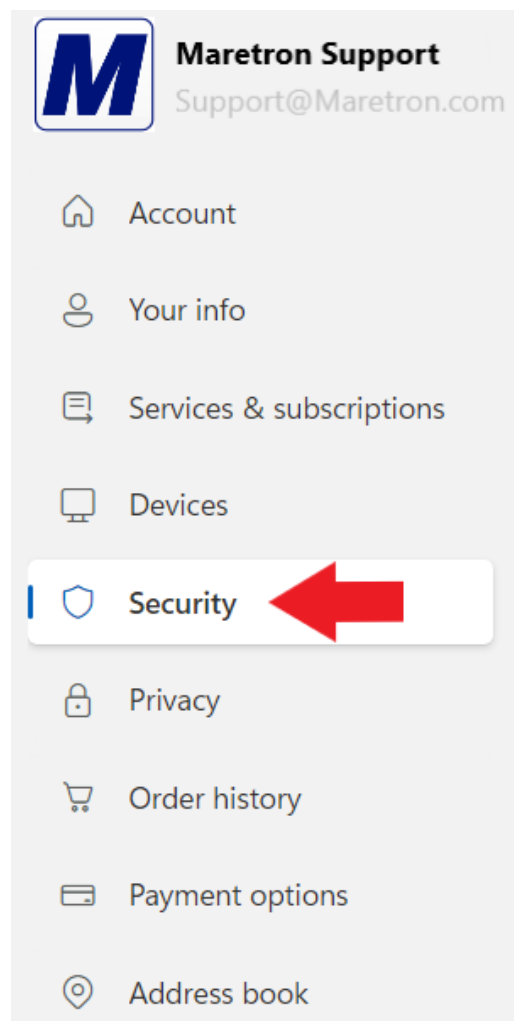


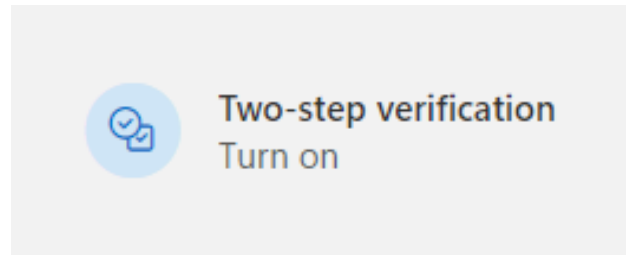
N2KView Email Alerts - Outlook APP Password Setup

App Password for Outlook N2KView Email Setup

1. Sign in to your Outlook/Live/Hotmail Account at <https://login.live.com/>
2. Select the Security option on the left-hand pane.



3. In the upper-right section of the Security screen, turn on Two-step verification, if not already enabled.
*This requires a mobile phone number associated with the account.



4. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the setup process.

Set up two-step verification

Two-step verification adds an extra layer of protection to your account. After you've turned it on, we'll ask you to enter an additional security code when you sign in. We'll provide this security code only to you. In the following steps, we'll help you:

1. Make sure you have up-to-date security info where you can receive security codes.
2. Create app passwords for apps and devices (such as Xbox 360, Windows Phone 8 (or earlier), or mail apps on your other devices) that don't support two-step verification codes.

3. Utilize the newly generated password back into the N2KView application email setup. Press Done to close menu when complete.
